to enable the whole school community to find fullness of life through the discovery and development of their talents, and through the setting of positive and realistic goals;

to promote Christian values within the school community and through its life (centred on collective worship) and its active links with the wider community and church, to encourage in pupils a sense of honesty, commitment, self-reliance, responsibility, respect for others and a healthy self-esteem;

to ensure that for all those involved with the school the experience of relationships within the school has a formative and enriching influence on their understanding of relationships;

to stimulate in the pupils a sense of curiosity, excitement and enjoyment about the world;

to encourage the whole school community to search for truth, meaning and purpose in life; to provide an opportunity to search for a faith by which to live.
