From 13th April we will be charging a fee of £5 for the countersigning of passports.

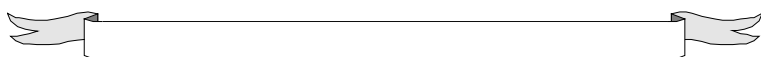

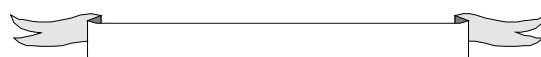
